Good Afternoon Leanne and apologies for the delayed response.

As indicated to you verbally the consultation process regarding the draft JETP IP has followed a two track process.

- There have been constituency engagements for representatives of organisations in the civil society, labour, youth and business sectors. These have been convened by the PCC on behalf of the PCFTT.
- 2. There have been 4 roundtables convened with experts in their individual capacities who commented on the accuracy, underpinning assumptions and further work needed. These were convened by the Secretariat and addressed the Electricity Sector, the Just Transition, Electric Vehicles and Green Hydrogen.

Your engagement with the PCFTT took place prior to the decision to convene the constituency sessions and once they were scheduled we were under the impression that your request for organisational representatives to participate in the discussion would be addressed through that process.

Please note that the Finance and Implementation working groups have not yet been convened.

We are awaiting the required Government approval processes to be concluded and for the PCFTT to decide on the form of the consultative process going forward.

We look forward to engaging with yourselves at that stage and look forward to your responses to the IP that has been prepared.
